

Tasha's dance students have graced the stages of the Treasure Coast for over ten years. Audiences raved about the energy and passion



of the shows created and performed by the Wings to Fly Dance Company. The shows Quest (2010 & 2011), Time (2012), and Life (2013) were emotional and memorable masterpieces that staged the incredible talents of local performers. "It's rewarding to inspire performers to reach beyond perceived limits to find their true and full potential."

Before moving to Florida, Tasha lived in Japan and performed with Madonna, Christopher Cross, Dianna Ross, Earth Wind and Fire, and Cyril Takayama (a magician). With 25 years of experience, she has worked as a choreographer in Guys and Dolls, Rocky Horror Picture Show, Cats, Geki Dan Shiki, and for many contemporary dance companies here and abroad. Music videos include Namie Amuro, Southern Allstars, and Salt N Pepa. She created events and shows for Budweiser, Coca Cola, Toyota, MAC Makeup, Prada, Sony, Virgin Cinemas and various cabaret shows. Commercials include Glico, Sony, Pizza Hut, Swatch, and Suzuki.

Tasha is the Executive Director of both WTFDC and the The Place for Yoga where she provides individualized therapeutic yoga and meditation. Tasha works with her family to create an exciting diverse repertoire, engaging in unique collaborations with a wide variety of talent.

Founding Director Dancer Tena Patterson

Tena's impressive repertoire as a professional dancer, teacher and choreographer bloomed in Toronto with the National Ballet School and by 18 with Vancouver's Pacific Ballet Company. Theater dancing in shows like West Side Story, Guys and Dolls Gypsy, & Oklahoma plus Telethons

filled her dance card. In 1995 she formed the Florida Performing and Visual Arts Program for persons with disabilities with the Arc of St. Lucie County. Believing "everyone should have the opportunity to perform", her work continues with WTFDC. Tena also writes children's books, the latest, *Friendly the 911 Kite*, is for sale at Barnes and Noble. Now 71, she shows us all how it's done!



Director, Dancer & Choreographer Tara Marie Anstensen

Tara Anstensen has been employed by the Martin Health System for over 12 years as a Physical Therapy Assistant. She was the Assistant Supervisor for individuals with disabilities at the Arc of St. Lucie County for over 10 years. Her background as a professional dancer included working on Princess Cruises, performing with Diana

Ross, C&C Music Factory and Cyndi Lauper. Her extensive experience with therapy and with individuals with disabilities gives her an exceptional insight on how to facilitate experiences beyond what you could think possible. Tara has a sincere appreciation for creativity and exploration of music and movement and shares that love with her students. She is thrilled to be with WTFDC integrating dancers with and without disabilities.

#### Raydel Caceres - International Principal Guest Artist

Born in Cuba, Raydel began studying dance at the age of 8 at the National School of Ballet in Havana. He performed many soloist roles at an early age. Since 2000 he has been cast in more than 21 various roles, receiving accolades from many dance critics for his leaps, spins in the air, pirouettes, musicality, and freshness of style throughout his *exact and clean* performances! In 2011 he was both cast as the lead role and co-choreographed *Silent Roar* in Hollywood, CA. A notable quote of his:

When I dance I'm completely absorbed by the music, the passion, the fear and the pain of the story.

Highlighting some of his international guest artist appearances, Mr. Caceres has performed with leading professional ballet companies in Cuba, Brazil, Oklahoma, California, Florida, and currently is the principal artist at the Twin Cities Ballet of Minnesota. Recent dance roles include La Bayadere (Florida Classical Ballet 2013), Swan Lake (California Ballet 2013), Midnight Summer Dream (SCB Los Angeles 2013), Romeo & Juliet (Oklahoma City Ballet 2015), and The Nutcracker (Twin Cities Ballet 2015). WTFDC is thrilled to have Raydel join us for our exciting *Journey*!

#### Ana Bolt-Turrall - Guest Artist and Speaker

Ana is a consummate artist and mentor, her bio could fill this program! She is a certified K-12 dance, physical education and theatre educator, and also certified with Polestar Pilates and Pilates Method Alliance CPT. Her repertoire techniques include Gyrokinesis and Active Isolated Stretching (AIS). Ana has spent a lifetime refining her craft and combining the art of dance with her heart for service. Ana's many active projects include outreach program collaborations at women's shelters, pursuing her MFA at Jacksonville University and her residency at White Oak. Ana is presently teaching and inspiring the youth in the Palm Beach and Port Saint Lucie areas. #### Amanda Irwin - Dancer

Amanda began professional training in Florida at the Palm Beach Ballet Center. Following her continued training at the Univ. of NC School of the Arts, she danced with North Carolina Dance Theatre (now the Charlotte Ballet). There she had the opportunity to work with Patricia McBride, Jean Pierre Bonnefoux, Mark Diamond, Michael Vernon, Dwight Rhoden, and Mark Godden. She spent time with the American Contemporary Ballet in Los Angeles and Reach Dance Company in West Palm Beach before joining Dance Theatre of Tennessee in Nashville. Amanda is currently teaching ballet on the Treasure Coast and is passionate about sharing her knowledge and wisdom with younger generations. She is thrilled to choreograph SFDC's production of *Cinderella* at the Sunrise Theater this June 4<sup>th</sup> (see ad within). This is Amanda's first year with Wings to Fly Dance Company! She is excited to have a platform for developing her own artistic expression through dance and choreography.

#### Mary Weeks – Dancer

Mary has trained for almost five years at the South Florida Dance Company and has attended workshops at Walnut Hill School for the Arts in Natick, Mass. She has been with WFTDC for three years and danced in our last show, Life. Reflecting "Dancing with WTFDC is a blessing and an honor. I love the energy and connection we have with each other, and the ability to release and breathe through the movement of dance. I so love the passion I feel while performing with company members in wheelchairs". Mary has worked in many performances with SFDC and in a variety of community shows. Her day job is in Stuart as a Licensed Esthetician and she so enjoys her time and energy with WTFDC.

<u>Mikayla Bradford – Dancer</u> This is Mikayla's third year with WTFDC, having performed in Life in 2013. She made an appearance as Snow Queen in SFDC's Christmas Carol. She has a degree in Fine Arts for Dance from Indian River State College where she appeared in numerous performances and is currently working as a dental assistant. She has rediscovered her passion for dance and is thankful that the Treasure Coast has the Wings To Fly Dance Company for her to pursue her dreams!

Hailing from Colorado, Lisa was a dance major at the Denver School of the Arts and the University of Northern Colorado. Performing at Walt Disney World brought her to Florida in 2003 and she settled in Port Saint Lucie in 2010. Lisa is a Physical Therapist Assistant for Martin Health System by day, and new mom to a beautiful little girl by night. She has danced with companies such as Cleo Parker Robinson Dance, Kim Robards Dance (Denver), and Voci Dance (Orlando). She has also performed with the National Broadway Touring Company of Joseph and the Amazing Colored Dreamcoat! Lisa has studied under many dancers and choreographers, learning numerous styles ranging from modern and Egyptian, to hula and Cirque aerial arts. She loves using dance to reach and enlighten her community and is honored to be performing with WTFDC.

Kaileigh Bates - Dancer

Kaileigh has been dancing for nineteen years, the last five being with Wings to Fly and their performances of *Quest*, *Time*, and *Life*. Previous theatre credits include Tiger Lily (Peter Pan), Chiffon (Little Shop of Horrors), Chorus (Jekyll and Hide) with Shiloh Theatrical Productions, Dainty June (*Gypsy*), and as a Kit Klub Dancer (*Cabaret*) at South Fork High. She has also been practicing yoga for two years, breathing properly to help build the strength needed to reach her potential as a dancer. In the community she works with individuals with developmental disabilities and that has become her favorite part about dancing with Wings to Fly – demonstrating that anything is possible!

Angel Tamayo – Guest Dancer Angel is a student at Indian River State College. He majors in dance while pursuing a degree in Performing Arts. A former dance company owner told him: in less than four years of dancing, you have shown exceptional potential. Words that moved Angel to a deeper understanding: Art is simply how you portray it to be, there is no right or wrong answer. If you found the point of the story and it touched you, you're already winning. Angel was the captain of Ft. Pierce's Westwood High School's Pink Panthers Dance Team which took 2<sup>nd</sup> place in a Vero Beach competition. He performed in SFDC's Christmas Carol and WTFDC sees him a potential new member of our company!

#### Samara Shevlin - Dancer

Born locally, Samara began at The Dance Academy of Stuart at the age of three. She continued her dance education at Florida Arts & Dance Company, and later became a member of WTFDC under Tasha's instruction. She's performed in local productions with each of these studios as well as The Rock School of Ballet in Pennsylvania, and attended The Joffrey South Workshop in Georgia. In 2013 the prestigious Joffrey Ballet School in NYC accepted Samara and she studied, choreographed, and performed under the instruction of artistic director Michael Blake. Here she studied with principal dancers, teachers and choreographers stemming from New York City Ballet, American Ballet Theater, Alvin Ailey, as well as master classes from Sonya Tayeh, and Ellenore Scott at Broadway Dance Center. Samara now explores her passion of dance with WTFDC. She is currently working as assistant choreographer to Tasha and has taught at the Dance Academy of Stuart, the South Florida Dance Company, and the Florida Arts & Dance Company.

John Barnes – *Singer*John presently teaches the choral music program at The Pine School in Hobe Sound. John has his Master's degree in Music from Georgia Southern University and is truly a hidden gem on the Treasure Coast. 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




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
